

2023 ENDOFOUND FULL GRANT PROPOSAL APPLICATION

Instructions:

- Ensure that you read the [2023 Request for Proposals page](https://www.endofound.org/research) (<https://www.endofound.org/research>) on our website prior to applying.
- Complete each section below.
- Ensure that your application is organized according to the sections below and is a **maximum of 7 pages** (excluding references), **in 11 point, single-spaced, arial font, and 1 inch margins**. You may include spaces between the different sections. We advise using the current document, with the instructions deleted, to structure your application.
- Once finished, submit the application in **PDF format** to research@endofound.org by 5 pm on **September 1, 2023** for review. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.

1. Abstracts (Please include a scientific abstract and lay abstract)

2. Project Title

3. Institution Name

4. Key Personnel and Contact Information

Provide a list of all key personnel involved with the project, including their contact information, credentials and an explanation of how this background will enrich project outcomes. Ensure the Principal Investigator and grant management contact (person responsible for serving as a proposal liaison and providing reports to the Foundation), are included in this section.

5. Project Narrative (maximum 4 pages)

Organize the application according to the following sections:

- *Background;*
- *Aims and significance (including the need for the research);*
- *Hypothesis and how expected outcomes may benefit the endometriosis community;*
- *Any preliminary data that may support the proposal (optional);*
- *Methodology including key metrics;*
- *Estimated timeline for project milestones and completion.*

6. Requested Amount and Budget (maximum \$50,000 will be awarded over two years)

Include a narrative with an explanation of direct costs. EndoFound requests that indirect costs are limited to 10% of the overall budget per year (e.g. if the requested amount is \$50,000, indirect costs will cover a maximum \$2,500 per year).

7. Publishing Goals

Describe where you plan to publish your data once the investigation is complete.
